The Westerly division thereof contains 101 Acres & allowance which Isaac Peden wishes to Patent Seperate from the other in consequence of a sale made by the said Robert Reley to the said Peden as will more fully appear by a reference had to the Bill of Sale, or conveyence dated the 20<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup>. 1786 - the other or Easterly division contains 192 Acres and Allow<sup>e</sup>. to be Patented to Robert Reley. ~
