



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 184 1/2 & 33 P^{cs} and allowance 1/2 Being part of a larger Tract of 210 1/2 & 134 P^{cs} and allowance 1/2 of Land which was Originally Surveyed by William Mathews late DS on the 25th of the 2^d mo 1766 for Jacob Grove Assignee of William Robb. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 200^{cs} dated the 5th day of July 1763. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger tract of Land on the 20th day of April AD. 1811 for and at the request of the owner Hugh Long who has now desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the 30th day of September AD. 1816.
