



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>00</sup> dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April AD 1794 was surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817 for Hugh Ross the above described Tract of Land containing Four hundred Eighteen Acres fifty four perches and allowance of six percent for Roads &c and that the same was divided as above stated Between Elson Spencer & Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Hugh Ross for the purpose of obtaining separate patents & at the time of making said survey the above named Elson Spencer was in possession of the same and he had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards often acres cleared & fenced & the same is situate in Venango Township Crawford County Pa.
