



The above described tract of sixteen Acres & five perches & allowance of six PCent for Roads & $\frac{1}{2}$ is part of a larger Tract of Twenty Acres & eighty three perches & allowances situate in Guilford Township Franklin County which was Surveyed the 11th of October 1809 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Reichart bearing date the 15th of August 1809. Resurveyed the above part for John Reichart the 8th of March 1822.

N.B. The part marked A appears to be cut off and held by a prior Survey made for Nicholas Bittinger in right of Jacob Oswalt by Warrant bearing date the 8th of June 1762. It will be observed that some of the above courses vary from the Original I found it necessary in order to follow the marked lines on the Ground.
