



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania. Being the greatest part of a Tract of one hundred acres of Allowance formerly belonging to Adam Shoemaker but late to Peter Miller (the whole being not yet Patented. The said Peter Miller lately sold the above Part thereof to Elias Weber. Beginning at Stone in the Line of a Tract of George Dutt's Land thence by the same and by Land of Bastian Knowss South 50 <sup>degrees</sup> East 70 perches to a Stone, a Corner now of Jacob Wickert's Land thence by the same and by Land of Andrew Giering Land South 40 degrees West 131 perches to a stone Set for a corner of Michael Shneiders Land thence by the same North 77 <sup>degrees</sup> West 74 perches and 6 Tenths to a Stone in the Road leading to (b) also in the Line of a Tract of Frederick Marling's Land. Thence by the Said Land and Road North 4 <sup>degrees</sup> West 26 perches to a Stone in the Line of late John Nickol Millers but now Michael Shneiders Land Thence by the same North 40 <sup>degrees</sup> East 45 perches to a Stone and East 20 perches to a Stone and North 40 degrees East 88 perches to the Place of Beginning Containing Seventy one Acres and 110 perches Strict, or Sixty Seven Acres and 100 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads Divided for the said Elias Weber on the 27<sup>th</sup> April Anno 1784.
