



Situated in Millford Township formerly Turkey Foot in Bedford County and Surveyed the 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1783. In pursuance of two Warrants the one in the name of John Stump for 50<sup>ac</sup> dated 9<sup>th</sup> May 1774 the other in the name of John Wilson for 100<sup>ac</sup> dated the 1<sup>st</sup> March 1775. Note they include a considerable part of a Survey made for Rich<sup>d</sup> Brown <sup>in Right of Richard Wells</sup> and Returned into the Office as represented by the dotted lines but Herman Husbands the present owner of this not contented therewith insisted on executing the above alledging a prior Right &c. the Claim Represented by ye Dotted Lines Relinquished - See a Note of a M<sup>r</sup> Mcleans on Rich<sup>d</sup> Wells D<sup>t</sup> Ret<sup>d</sup> &c 16<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>t</sup> 75
