



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the eighth day of November 1734 Surveyed unto Frytz Rymer a Tract of Land situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of Joseph Grove's land thence by the same North East eighty three perches to a post in a line of George Trumbaur's land thence by the same South east Sixty eight perches to a post in a line of Paul Hyle's land thence by the same south west thirteen perches and by Vacant land the same Course Seventy Perches to a post thence by land of John Johnson North West two perches and by land of s^d Frytz Rymer Sixty Six Perches to the place of Beginning Containing Thirty^{three} acres with the usual allowance of Six P. Cent.
