



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1st day of May 1775 and order of Survey rec<sup>d</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847 Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1847 to Thomas Reeves the above described Tract of Land Situate in Lackawaxen Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County on Masthope Creek about two miles from Delaware River Containing one hundred & Seventeen acres eleven perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
