



Situated on the waters of the east branch of French Creek in district No. 1 surveyed the 1st day of June 1799 in pursuance of a warrant and a warrent of the Surveyor Genl. (upon an order of the board of Property) dated the 16th of May 1799 in the name of Amos Parks dated the 10th day of April 1793, containing four hundred & nine acres and seventy three perches and the allowance of six per cent
