



The above described tract of forty nine acres & twenty perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c is part of a larger tract of 76 acres & 9 perches surveyed 20th August 1791 in pursuance of a warrant granted Alexander James John and Robert Potts bearing date 17th September 1784 situate part in Fannet & part Metal Townships Franklin County the above part was surveyed & divided off the 30th October 1829 by the undersigned under the direction of William Hamilton late D Surveyor Certified 13th May 1830
