



A draught of a tract of land called Sumersett situate in Lycoming Township in the County of Northumberland in the late Purchase made of the Indians Surveyed on the 29th day December 1792 to the heirs of Major Abraham Latcha deceased in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Stewart of Paxton dated the 17th May 1785 & numbered 234 for three hundred & forty acres quantity surveyed three hundred & sixty three acres & fifteen perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
