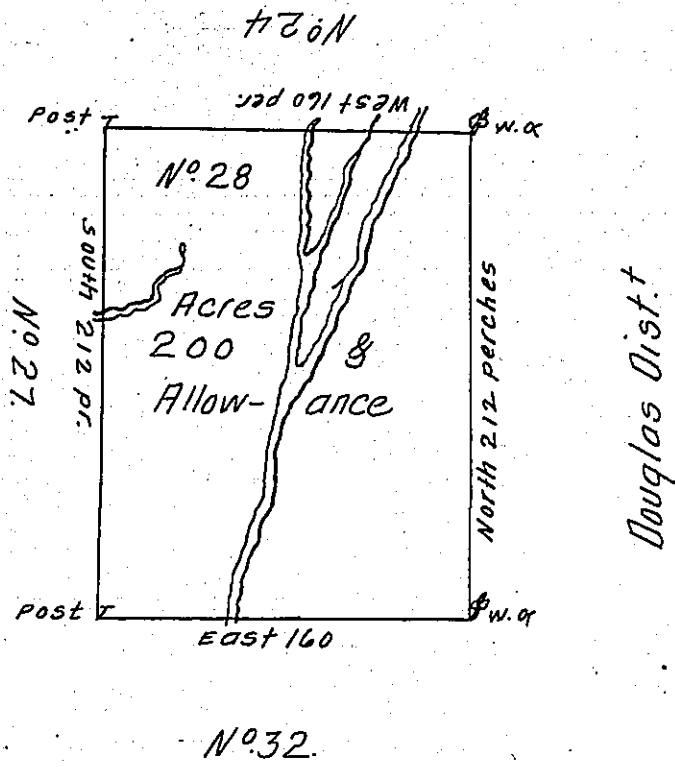


Part of District No 3



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the Sale of Certain lands therein Mentioned & by Virtue of A Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor Generall for the State of Pennsylvania to Me Directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th day of August 1783. The Above tract of land Containing two hundred Acres and Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads &c. was Surveyed on the 8th day of June 1785 by
