



Situated on Two Mile Run a Branch of Beaver River that empties into Beaver on the West Side Two Miles above Fort Mackintosh being the Second Survey Westward of the Division Line between District No 2 and No 1 in the first Parallel Southward of the third Square from the Northern Boundary of that Tract of Country appropriated by Law for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depriciation &c in District No 1 & Surveyed in the Month of June 1785 Pursuant to Instructions Given by John Lukens Esq Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783.
