



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 6th day of June 1817 containing 49 Acres & 62 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c. in pursuance of a Warrant granted Jacob Babbit bearing date 16th of May 1817. Situate on the line between Washington & Greene Counties. 17 Acres & 123 perches in Washington County in Findlay township & 31 Acres & 99 perches in Morris township in the County of Greene at the head of Hunters fork of Wheeling - Called "Calvin,"
