Surveyed (by Henry Wilson) for James Wilson, Martha Blatt & others, the fifth day of April A.D. 1880. It being a part of a larger tract of 245 acres, 40 perches and allowance. Originally surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1766 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Finley dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1763. Resurveyed by order of the Board of Property the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June A.D. 1813
