Surveyed for John Struthers Sen<sup>r</sup> July 3<sup>d</sup> 1785. In pursuance of a Certificate obtained in his own name from the Commissioners of Virginia for adjusting Claims to upatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania & Ohio which Certificate is mislaid but regularly entered in the Surveyors office of Yohogania - and to us Transmitted from the Surveyors Generals Office of this State
