In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain Lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 the above Tract of Land containing two hundred Sixteen Acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6 p Cent for roads &c. was survey<sup>d</sup> on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
