



The Draught of a tract of Land situate in Spring Township Centre County Containing two hundred and fifty two Acres, one hundred and fifty nine perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c^s Surveyed the 26th day of March 1812 in pursuance of a warrant Granted to James Resides dated the 27th day of February 1812.

On the above described Tract of land there is about eighteen or twenty Acres Cleared, a Cabin house and Barn, and James Resides and his family residing on the same - and by the best information I could obtain the first improvement was made the last of May or the first of June in the year 1792.
