



A draught of a tract of land situate in Dover township in the County of York surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> November 1791 to John Righabough in pursuance of a warrant to him dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1791 containing one hundred acres and  $\frac{1}{8}$  and allowance of six acres  $\frac{1}{100}$  cent for roads.
