We the commissioners appointed for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monunghela Yohogania and Ohio do hereby certify that Joshua Russel is entitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Ohio on the waters of Buffaloe creek to include his settlement made in the year of our Lord one thos and seven hundred and seventy four.

Given under our hands at Redstone old fort this twenty second day November 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
