



The above is a draught of a tract of land on the waters of Chartiers creek, Washington surveyed for Joseph Ray May 31st 1787 in consequence of a warrant dated at Philadelphia March 19th 1787 called the Woodcock containing one hundred eighty-eight acres and three roods with allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
