



A draught of a survey called "Campbell's Victory" situate on Chartiers Creek in Washington County contain^g 269 1/2 ac^s strict measure executed Augst ye 10th 1790 in consequence of part of a Virga. ~~Treasury~~ warrant for 400 ac. N^o 2 dated Decem^r 1st 1779 and located with ye County Surv^r Ap^r 28th 1780 in ye name of Rubin Rutherford, who assigned to Geo. Rootes who assigned to Ja^s Campbell. Ret^d 24th Aug^t 1790.

Note the whole of the survey on the Virga Warr^t cont^g 394 ac^s 35 ps. was ret^d to ye office, but James Campbell have^d sold this part to Charles Campbell & And^w Ritchie and they being desirous of a seperate patent I have divided ye survey for that purpose.

This survey is agreable to the order of ye Board dated Nov^r 5th 1789 excepting that And^w Ritchie has allowed the ass^{ess} of Peter Kerns something more than he was entitled to by said order.
