



By virtue of a warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> January 1774 surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> May 1814 (by order of George Palmer) to Detrick Reese the above described tract of land situate on the Easton and Wilkes-barre turnpike and on the waters of Lehigh near the Pine Swamp in the County of Northampton containing one hundred and ten acres and the allowance of six pcent &c.
