



Situate in Boggs township Centre County (formerly Bald Eagle township Northumberland county) containing twenty nine acres one hundred and sixty four perches and allowance of six per cent (being part of a larger tract surveyed for Joseph Hopkins Jur. the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1784 pursuant to his application N<sup>o</sup> 1569 dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769) divided as above for Enoch Passmore the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February 1828.
