



Situate in Cordorus township York County and resurveyed nearly by the old lines the 17th day of May 1790 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Peter Runk then of Lancaster County for 100^a & which was surveyed by W^m Buchannan DYS^r - but not returned -

N.B. Yost Runk who is the present owner had taken a new warrant for 200^a for part of the above tract dated Jan^y 21st 1790 but finding the circumstances as above I have returned the whole on the old warrant as it was all included in Buchannans survey except what is represented by the dotted line at A.
