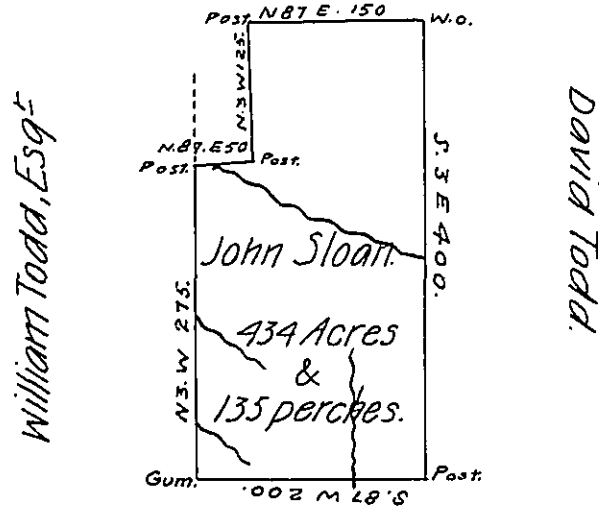

Surveyed the 23 day of May 1798 for John Sloan 434 Acres & 135 perches of Land, with the allowance of Six per Cent & c. by virtue of an Actual Settlement, made the Second day of March, One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Six. Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 8, N.W. of the Allegheny River, on the waters of Buffalo Creek and a Small Branch Entering into the Allegheny River.
