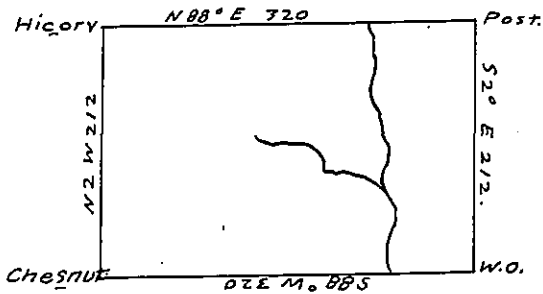


West Boundary of Penna
