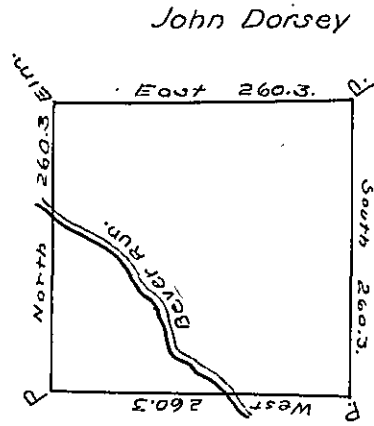

 Falkirk containing 400 acres, with the usual allowance of 6p<sup>t</sup> Cent
