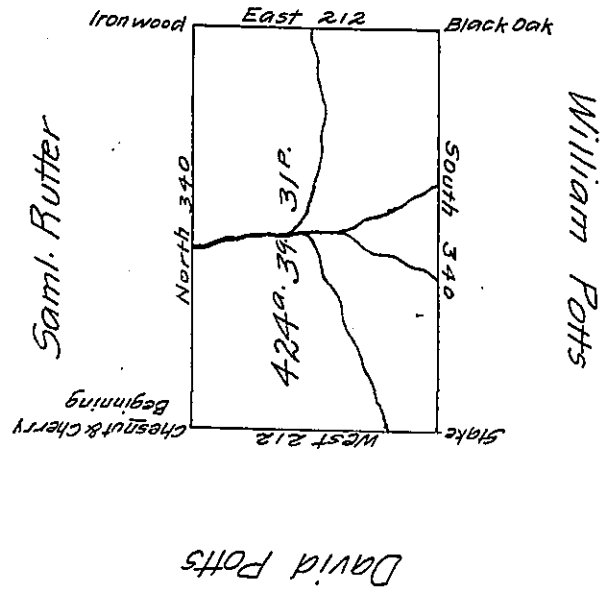


Donation Line



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 27th. of January 1795. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Potts for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th. of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land granted to David Potts Called Iron Bank Containing four hundred and twenty four Acres three quarters and thirty one poles together with the usual allowance of Six pr. Cent for Roads.
