



A Draught of an Island situate in the river Susquehanna, in conestogoe Township, in the County of Lancaster, called creeks Mouth Island, near the Mouth of Conestogoe creek opposite on that side to Land of Philip Orwine and others and on the York Side by an Island claimed by Daniel Kindig distant from the Lancaster shore about three hundred yards containing Six acres and three quarters Strict Measure Surveyed the 7th of September Anno domini One thousand eight hundred & sixteen. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 8th. of August A.D. 1816, granted to George Parson.
