



In pursuance of a warrant for 60 acres dated the 14th. day of January 1818 granted to James Peterson Junier was surveyed on the 10th. Day of May 1818 the above described tract of containing 61 acres 127 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. situated in Fairfield Township Crawford County and that the said James Peterson Junier was Residing on the same and there appeared to be upwards of 10 acres of the Land cleared & fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man.
