



Situate in Warrington Township in the County of York, Containing within the black lines as above set forth 112as. & 60ps. & allowance Being part of a larger Tract of 206as. & 102ps. & allowance which was originally Surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 8th day of May 1789, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Edmund Philips for 50as. dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1754. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1821 for Abraham Baker the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
