March 8th. 1817. Situate in Derry township Westmoreland County, it Being part of a tract said to Contain in the whole four hundred and fourteen acres and fifty four perches and allowance, which was Surveyed by John Moore then District Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Patten in trust for the Heirs of John Patten Deceased bearing date November 6th. 1786.
