



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland joining the ~~Center Square~~ and marked in a General Plan of said Town No. 144. Situate on the West side of Hanover Street and adjoining the North side of the Center Square. Containing in Breadth on Hanover Street Sixty feet, and in length at the North side two hundred and twenty six feet, and at the South side one hundred and Sixty five feet Nine Inches Bounded Southward with the Center Square, Eastward with Hanover Street, Northward with Lot No. 145 and Westward with a Twenty feet Alley. — Returned into the Secretarys Office the 17th. day of June 1772. by Warrt granted the 16th. Inst. to the Revd. John Steel.
