



In pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey to me Directed dated the 6th day of November 1769 granted to Edward Stiles and Thomas Riche for two <sup>Water</sup> Bank Lotts in the City of Philad<sup>a</sup>. I did on the 13th day of April 1770 Resurvey the <sup>two</sup> above Described two Lotts ~~of~~ and find them to be Situate on the East side of Front Street from Delaware <sup>River</sup> Stiles's Lott Contains North and South on Delaware or Kings Street 82 feet and Riche's joining Northward of said Stiles's Containing on sd. Delaware & Kings Street 30 feet Bounded Northwd by a Lott formerly Joseph Turners now sd. Riche's Eastward by Delaware River at the Extent of 250 feet from the East side of Front Street Southwd by a New Ten feet Alley and Westward by Delaware or King Street aforesaid.
