



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 6th day of January 1770 I did on the 23d. of the same Month Survey and lay out for Robert Smith of the City of Philad^a House Carpenter the above Described Lot of Ground Situate in the District of Southwark Containing in Breadth on Second Street (Enlarged by 4 feet being added to the West side thereof) Eighteen feet and on George Street thirty three feet and in Length on Cedar Street 256 feet. Bounded Eastward by Second Street Enlarged as aforesaid Northward by Cedar Street, Westward by George Street, and Southward by Robert Smith's other other Ground.
