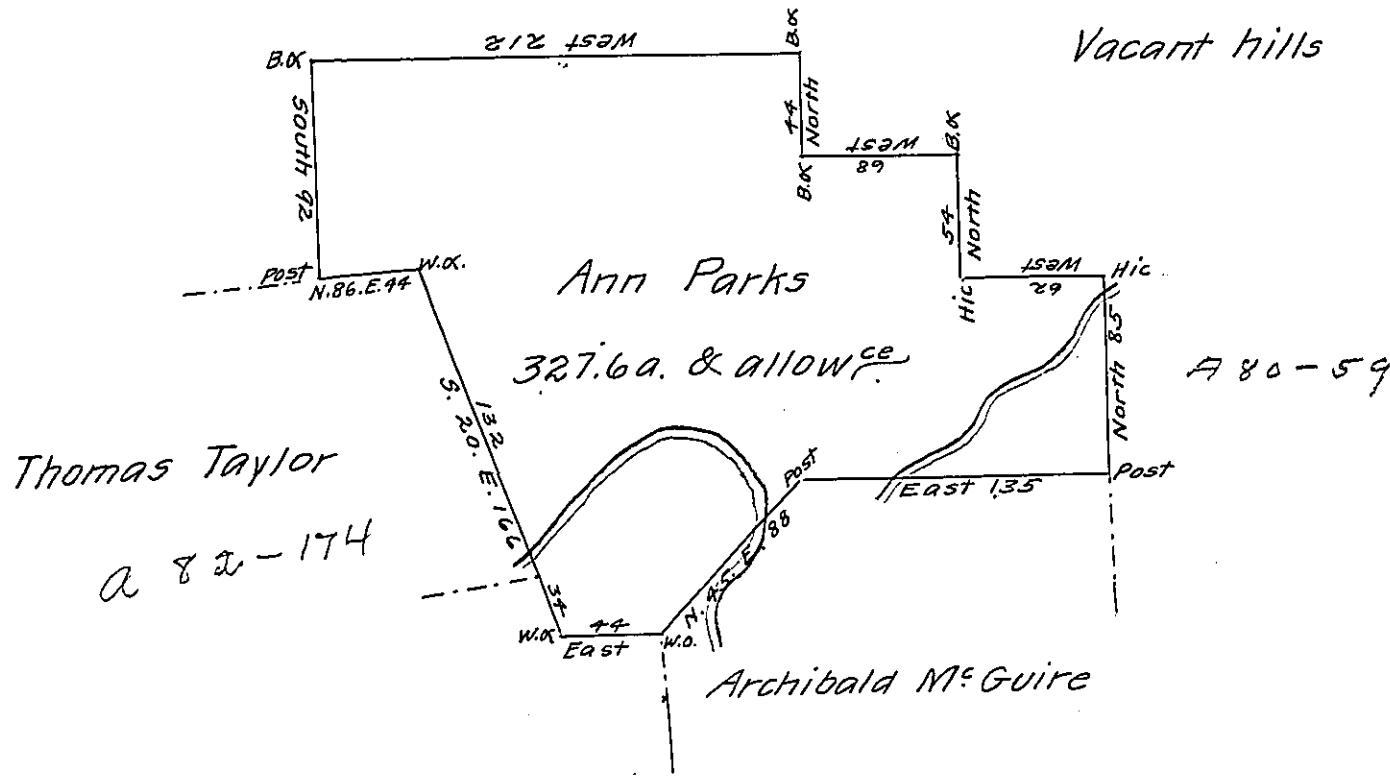


Vacant Land

Survey'd to Ann Parks on the 4th. Day of June 1774. The above Described Tract of Three hundred twenty seven Acres & an half of an Acre & the usual allowance of Six pCt. Situate on Plumb Creek Including some Indian Camps about six Miles above where the Kittaning Path crosseth said Creek in Westmorland County. By Warrant of the 20th. Day of December 1773.
