



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 15th. January 1787 Surveyed the 22d. June 1787 to John Palmer (Son of George Palmer) the above described tract of Land situate about six miles South of the State line & about six miles from the Mohock branch of Delaware River on a Creek Emptying into Susquehanna—at the great Bent by an Old Tuscarora Town in Northampton County Containing four hundred and Eleven Acres fifty-eight perches & the allowance of Six pCent. &c.
