



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Codorus township in the County of York, Containing within the black lines 75as.& 91ps. and allowance, Being part of a larger tract of 228as. & 128ps. and allowance which was originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 5<sup>th</sup> of the 6<sup>th</sup> Month 1767 for Daniel Ham in pursuance of his Application No. 3605 for 300as. dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1767. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1818, at the request of Lewis Bup the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
