



A draught of Survey made in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Shins bearing ^{date} the 24th day of October 1788 containing 147 Acres and eighty perches and the usual allowance for Roads &c. Situate in Wayne township in the County of Greene on Dunkard Creek Surveyed 21st day of March 1828.

 It does not close exactly some part of the Land being very steep the Creek hill being almost inaccessible
 N.B. The above survey is made agreeably to the old marks and lines found on the ground it having been surveyed near forty years ago by the then Deputy Surveyor of Washington County.

The remainder of the old survey I cannot exactly describe but I know that it belongs to Peter Yeagar [&] the heirs of George Shins Jur. their assignees and Amos Morris.

If the Land department wish a report from me of the remaining ^{part of the} 300 As. they will please forward me a copy of the old Survey that I may be able to give them a particular account of what is now in the occupancy of each individual.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eleventh day of January 1907.
