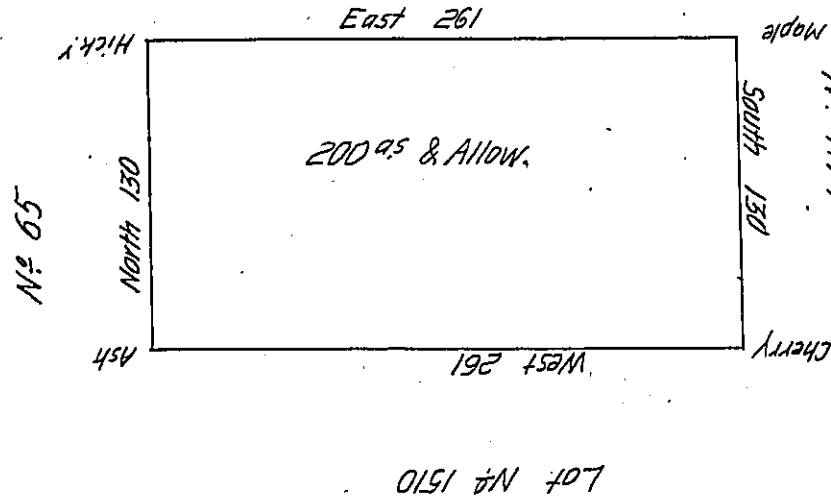

Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785 Intituled "an act for Directing the Mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth" & by order of the surveyor General With the Approbation of the Hon. the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1785 the Above Discribed tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. Of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c. No. MDXI situate in Dist. No. 7 on the west side of the Alleg. River in the County of Westmorland.
