Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen.<sup>l</sup> With the Approbation of the Hon.<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of Aug.<sup>r</sup> 1785 the Above Discribed tract of two Hundred A<sup>s</sup> & Allow. of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCXIII situate in Dist. N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland.
