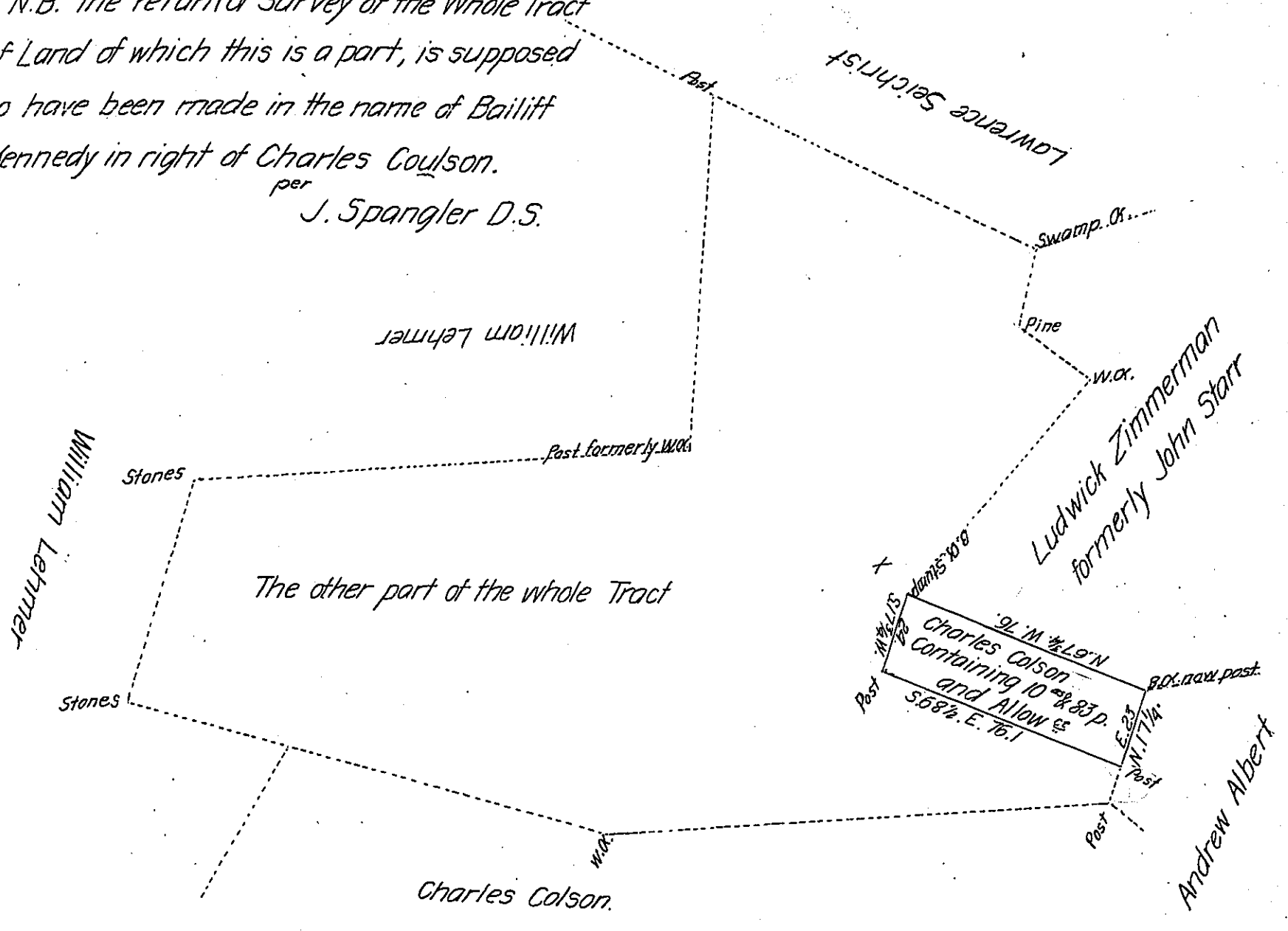

Colson. - and now Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1812 for and at the request of the owner John Shultz who desired that the Same should be returned for Confirmation.
