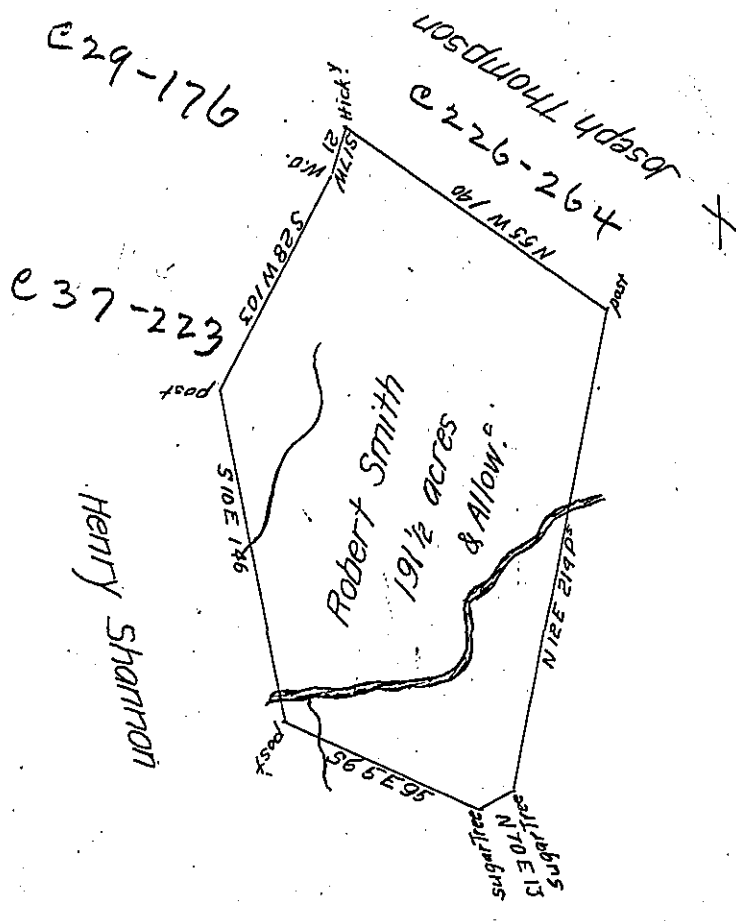

N.B. there is another Warrant for the same Ground Granted Robert Haslet bearing date February 27th 1786 being the prior Office Right but Smith is in Possession of the Premises, and Directed the Survey. (No return on Haslet)
