



A draught of a tract of land situate in Hereford Township in the County of Berks (formerly Philadelphia County) containing thirty six acres and 100 perches of land, together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads: Being near the half part of a tract of 74<sup>a</sup> 67 perches, that was formerly surveyed unto Matthias Harmbough in pursuance of a warrant of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May Anno. 1750 whose right to the same was vacated by another warrant, dated the sixth day of April Anno. 1767, and the above part thereof granted unto Conrad Schaub (al. Shoub) By virtue whereof the above was resurveyed unto him on the 16<sup>th</sup> April Anno. 1767. By order of the Surveyor General
