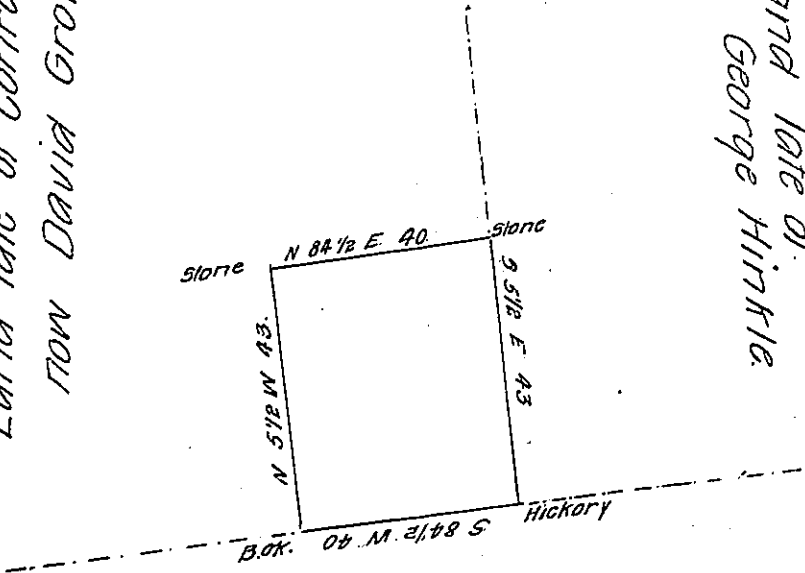

D. 1745
