



The warrant in the name of Isaac Smith
is dated 1 July 1784. James McGulloch.

In pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated
April 26 1810 Resurveyed September 27th 1810 the above de-
scribed Tract of land from an original survey to Isaac
Smith, Situate on the waters of Middle Creek Carraart Town-
ship Wayne County Containing Three hundred seventy nine
acres and thirty two perches and allowance of six P. Cent.
The lines marked (a) were formerly run and marked.
