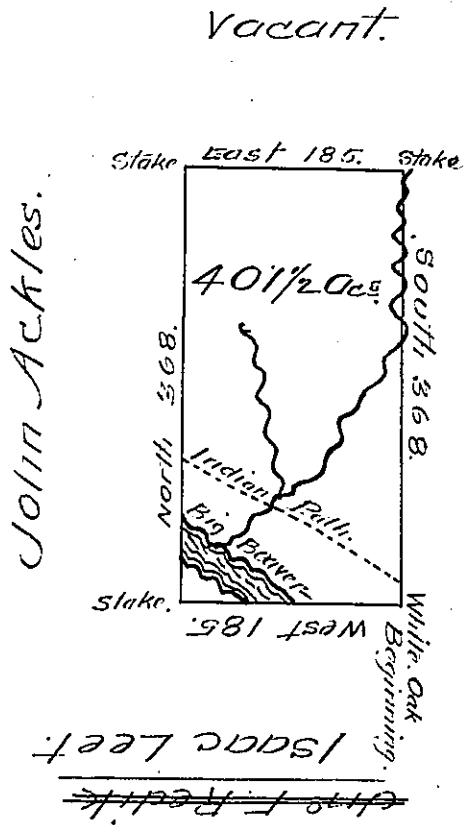


In pursuance of Thomas Ryerson.



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 9<sup>th</sup> of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Joseph Swearingin for 400 acres of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>y</sup>. 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land Granted to Isaac Leet ~~Marshall~~ <sup>one & an half</sup> Acres and the usual allowance of Six <sup>per</sup> Cent for Roads
