



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 14th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted To Steele Semple for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining William Semple to the Eastward and on the North side of Canaque-messing Creek North and West of the River Ohio - Called Bramble Containing four Hundred and thirty Six Acres three quarters and twenty five Poles, together with the usual allowance of Six Per. Cent for Roads
