County, now Berks, Land Survey'd thereon Twenty five acres and 63 perches and the allowance the Warrant in the Name of Valentia Smack Dated the fourth day of March 1790 Land Survey'd thereon one Hundred and thirty six acres and 20 perches and the allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent the whole was Survey'd for Valentia Smack on the Eighth day of March - 1790 the above discribed Tracts of Land situat in Alsace township Berks County Containing in the whole one Hundred Sixty one acres and 83 perches and the allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
